Dunnington is an attractive village, without the inconvenience or stress of York parking or shopping, and is easily reached from the city and surrounding areas.

The move to 13 York Street means there will be lots more space to fully display beautiful new spring collections by Romo, Osborne & Little, Zoffany, Voyage, Sanderson and Harlequin. The new shop will also be displaying, for the first time, distinctive mirrors, dramatic lamps by Drimmer of France and the finest rugs from Brink and Campman. Furthermore, the extra room will allow Fabric Gallery and Interiors to show off a full range of blind and curtain styles, curtain poles and their upholstery services.

"We are really looking forward to the extra space in our new shop. Customers will have lots more to see and experience and will have a more leisurely visit - we'll even be able to offer complimentary refreshments to our customers," concludes Bronia.
